**SEASON OF EPIPHANY** Epiphany is the short season between Christmas and Lent when we place a green covering on the communion table. Green refers to the growth we should pursue in our relationship with Jesus. But why? Epiphany signifies a realization by humans of the Glorious Descent of Jesus. It is the idea that they recognized who he really was, the Son of God, the Christ, the Messiah who gave up everything to reach us. Epiphany is recognizing that Jesus is God, and that he descended to us. We, then, respond likewise, with a willingness to give up everything for him. Imagine the growth in Christ you will experience during Epiphany as you submit yourself to him!
